Child with Chandipura virus infection dies in Sabarkantha

Sabarkantha, July 9

A SIX-YEAR-OLD boy from Rajasthan with a confirmed Chandipura virus (CHPV) infection died at the civil hospital at Himmatnagar in Sabarkantha district of Gujarat, an official said on Thursday.

Seven suspected CHPV patients -- all children between the ages of 2 and 11 -- were admitted to the hospital between June 26 and July 9, Resident Medical Officer (RMO) Dr Vipul Jani said.

"A boy who died tested positive as per the result received on July 6. The test result of another child, who died yesterday, is awaited while the third deceased child tested negative for the virus," he said.

The deceased child with confirmed CHPV infection was identified as Rajkumar Damor (6), a resident of Udaipur in Rajasthan.

Two girls -- a two-year-old from Rajasthan and a three-year-old from Sabarkantha -- with suspected Chandipura virus infection are undergoing treatment and their reports were awaited. The report of a three-year-old boy tested negative and he was discharged, Dr Jani said.

The parents of a three-year-old girl, whose report is awaited, left with her without doctors' permission.

The children were from Rajasthan as well as Banaskantha, Panchmahal and Sabarkantha districts of Gujarat, Dr Jani said.

"A dedicated ward has been set up on the ground floor for the treatment of Chandipura virus cases," the RMO said.

In a release on Tuesday, the state government had said, "Survey in the affected villages found the presence of sand flies, the insect associated with the spread of the virus. As a result, intensive insecticide spraying has begun in and around homes, particularly in mud houses where sand flies are known to breed in wall cracks..."

The release added that adequate medicines and insecticidal powder had been supplied to health centres.

Health Minister Praful Pansheriya had said his department had initiated a "rapid containment operation".

PREPARE PERMANENT SOLUTION FOR FLOODING, OFFICIALS TOLD

CM announces Rs 500 cr for Surat creek project

City records nearly 30% of the season's total rainfall in the past one week

CHIEF MINISTER Bhupendra Patel on Thursday announced Rs 500 crore for development and deepening of the creek network in Surat city to provide a permanent solution to flooding during the monsoon season.

Patel was in Surat to take stock of the flood situation in the city following record rainfall since July 7.

Reviewing the flood situation, Patel warned of strict action against erring officials. Patel, accompanied by Union Jal Shakti Minister and Navsari MP C R Patil, reviewed the flood situation at a meeting held at Surat Municipal Corporation office, two days after the city witnessed 358 mm rainfall in 24 hours, triggering flood-like situation in several areas and disrupting normal life. Deputy Chief Minister Harsh Sanghavi, senior officials and local authorities were also present.

Speaking at the meeting, Surat Municipal Commissioner M Nagarajan said that the city recorded nearly 30 per cent of the season's total rainfall in the last one week.

"On Wednesday, 14.5 inches of rainfall was recorded in the city, the highest in Surat's history. Similarly, on July 6, the city recorded 6 inches of rainfall. A total of 3,600 people were rescued and 4,100 affected persons were shifted to relief centres. Two NDRF teams and five SDRF teams have been de-

ployed," Nagarajan said. The SMC has distributed 20,000 food & milk packets and water bottles. Medical teams have been sent to the affected areas for health check-ups. The areas along the banks of the creeks -- Bhedwad, Mithi, Udhna, Limbayat, and Varachha -- have been affected, he said.

Surat District Collector Tejas Parmar said a rapid survey of damages is underway in the affected areas, and the disbursement of financial assistance began on Wednesday. Around 40 kutcha and pucca houses across the district were damaged, he said.

The CM directed officials to ensure speedy disbursement of assistance to all those affected by the heavy rains. He emphasised the need for long-term preventive planning to ensure that such creek flooding does not recur. The CM also instructed officials to prepare and implement an immediate action plan to prevent administrative lapses that came to light during the flood situation. He said the State government will allocate Rs 500 crore for creek development.

He emphasised that the state government is in constant coor-

dination and communication with the local administration. Speaking on the occasion, Sanghavi said the government has ordered an inquiry into possible administrative lapses that led to the flooding.

Separate investigations will also be conducted into damage to recently constructed roads and other public infrastructure, and criminal cases may be registered if poor workmanship is found, he added.

Talking to The Indian Express, Officer on Special Duty in Surat and former Municipal Commissioner of Surat Shalini Agrawal said, "After rescue and relief operations carried out on July 7 and 8, a cleaning drive is underway in the flood-affected areas. Dindoli, Udhna and Limbayat areas on the banks of creeks are severely affected after the water level in the creeks rose rapidly. We have sent boats, trucks and other transport vehicles. We have formed over 250 teams of SMC-run SMIMER Hospital and New Civil Hospital for health checkups in the water-receded areas. Health check-ups were conducted in over 50,000 houses. After a week, we will carry out health check-ups in all the houses."

WITH THEIR shops and go-downs in floodwaters, hundreds of textile traders here are staring at losses worth crores of rupees. Tuesday's rain has left several market areas reeling, with water reaching a few feet deep in many basements.

Federation of Surat Textile Traders Association (FOSTTA) secretary Dinesh Katariya said: "Thousands of shops in different markets are flooded, causing losses worth hundreds of crores of rupees to traders and the industry."

Surat is a manufacturing hub for synthetic sarees and embellished dress materials. Finished products from here find space on shelves across the country.

Traders say it would be far more cost-effective if they sold the damaged fabrics without reprocessing them.

Sunil Jain, who owns a shop at Raghukul market, said: "The market is situated on the banks of Mithi Creek. As the water in the creek rose, it entered our basements. The market has more than 500 shops and go-downs. I have around 2,500 sarees in stock, and all of them have suffered damages. I have no other option but to sell them at a cheap rate. I must pay off my house loan... At present, we are removing the water stuck in basements. The market is under 7-foot-deep water."

The city has around 240 textile markets, which house 75,000 shops, centered around
